Randi Golub, certified Veterinary technician and owner of CatNurse on Call, will teach this fun and informative class on basic pet first aid Saturday, January 29th from 12 to 3pm at Greenhill. Participants will learn topics such as how to approach and assess an ill or injured animal, and CPR training, including practicing skills on a realistic CPR model. Heimlich maneuver will also be covered, and participants will learn the essentials of a pet first aid kit.

### Donation Opportunity for Seniors

Congress just passed a law letting people with IRAs (individual retirement accounts) to make tax free gifts to non-profits. Because it was enacted so late in the year, donors can make RETROACTIVE gifts through January 2011 that will count against the 2010 tax year. Gifts may be up to \$100,000 (per individual), you must be 70 1/2 or older, and only IRA plans are eligible.
