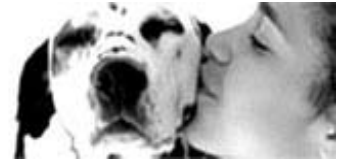

We rely on your generous donations.

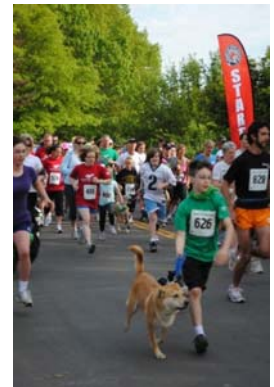
We shelter around 2,000 dogs, cats and small animals each year.

## Weathering the "Storm"

"Mend a Friend" fund gives 2nd chance to foster dog

### Pet of the Month

Last June, Greenhill took in a precocious playful 2 year old pit bull mix named "Storm", whose owner was forced to downsize into an apt. which wouldn't allow dogs. Soon after Storm's intake, the kennel staff noticed her limping. The Greenhill veterinarian examined her and found that her left hind knee was injured and painful. She was taken to [OVRA](#) (Oregon Veterinary Referral Associates) for a consultation with the orthopedic specialists, Dr. Csiszar and Dr. Daly. They diagnosed Storm with a genetic deformity of her knees and luxating patellas, a condition that more commonly occurs in small and toy breed dogs. In smaller dogs, this condition only sometimes requires major surgery, and most dogs resume their normal activities once healed. But in a

big, bouncy pitbull, it was causing a major problem with the leg, and would require extensive physical therapy & months of healing.

Through Greenhill's [Mend a Friend fund](#), which uses private donations to give more shelter animals life saving medical treatments in order for them to lead healthy lives with loving families, a dog like Storm has a chance of leading a normal happy life. Storm had surgery on her knee in July, but unfortunately, due to her playful, active nature, she re-injured the knee shortly afterwards. After numerous repeat trips to the orthopedist, 7 months of strict exercise limitations, pain medications, and the help of her amazing foster parents, Storm is now able to lead a normal, albeit physically modified, life. Though her foster family fell in love with Storm, they realized their lifestyle wasn't the best fit for her, reluctantly returning her to the kennel in hopes of giving this loving gal a second chance at finding her forever home.
